Dear Friend,

Since our team returned from Tanzania, several people have asked me to share a testimony about something that made this trip unique. Each mission trip is full of amazing God-moments but there is one day from this trip that I'll never forget. As we were driving to our second village, suddenly there was confusion about the location of our distribution. Usually, we use a church building so that people can come back and grow in their faith, and it also creates shelter from the hot sun and crowds. But on this day, the local pastor called to tell us that the crowd of people was gathered far away from the church, under a massive tree used for Bible study. The problem was that the tree was very hard to reach, and so we stopped the van to discuss our options and pray. It quickly became clear that we needed to go to where the people were waiting, and by the grace of God our van made it!

We proceeded with our first open air shoe distribution, under the massive tree at the foot of Mt. Kilimanjaro. It was amazing, and I kept looking over my shoulder to take in the breathtaking view of Mt. Kilimanjaro. The day prior, the team asked if we could get a quick peek of the mountain at some point during the trip. Not only did we get a "peek" but we got to soak in her beauty all day long! I love it when God takes our Plan A and transforms it into an even better Plan B. His ways are always good, and I encourage you to trust Him today if your plan A isn't going the way that you expected. We were able to serve so many people under that tree, and people walked for hours to reach us. Entire schools and villages came to hear the
