Meet one of our Partners

Meet Josias Mohanoe, our EHC ministry partner, in Lesotho, Africa. In Josias' report, he shared with us Hebrews 6:10, "God is not unjust; He will not forget your work and the love you have shown Him as you have helped His people and continue to help them." He wishes to share his sincerest gratitude for all of those who support SFJ. He says that seeing tears of joy from those who have received a pair of shoes is a miracle. Josias strongly believes that those who have heard and accepted Jesus will remember SFJ for the rest of their lives. Josias and his team are now working to reach over 1,000 souls with the Gospel and hope to train forty percent of them through discipleship training. He has asked us to pray for the following:



- God's wisdom for the volunteer distributors
- Protection over the herd boys who live high up in the mountains
- Greater resources for those living in the most remote areas
- Open doors to reach more unbelievers (prisoners, students, youth) with the Gospel message
- Strength and wisdom for the local pastors and overall unity in the church
- Greater humanitarianism in his country in order to alleviate suffering for those in combat

The reports that we have received from our EHC partner, Sydney, have moved us all! This nation was severely affected by the Ebola virus. When Sydney explained to the villagers that SFJ sent shoes as a token of God's love and our concern, the people were so excited that they began to shout!
