Pastor Busaka reached in to his supply of shoes that he was taking to the village and found just the right pair for the young boy. As Lephoi placed his foot in the shoe, he pulled out a colored picture that read, "Jesus loves you!" Lephoi will never be the same after being overwhelmed with the love of God that day.
