

Where In The World Is Guinea?

Guinea is a small country on the western coast of Africa, with a population of 12.4 million. Guinea declared its independence from France in 1958. French is the official language of Guinea and it's a predominantly Islamic country, with Muslims representing 85% of the population. Their biggest export is bauxite, which is used to make aluminum. The country was at the core of the 2014 Ebola outbreak, resulting in the death of over 2,500 Guineans. The literacy rate of Guinea is one of the lowest in the world. It is estimated that only 41% of adults are literate. Children, particularly girls, are kept out of school in order to assist their parents with domestic work or agriculture, or to be married. Malnutrition is a serious problem for Guinea, and HIV/AIDS and Malaria are also prevalent.

SFJ has sent shipments of shoes to Guinea in 2015 and 2017 and we are thrilled to partner with all that the Lord is doing in this nation. Please join us in prayer for the precious people of Guinea.
