Dear Friend,

My heart is moved to compassion each time that I hear stories from a refugee camp. Several years ago, we were blessed to send a double shipment (of 16,000 pairs of shoes) to a refugee camp in South Sudan and the ministry that happened was incredible. Well, today I just received a report from a refuaee camp Burkina in where the Lord is pouring out His love in a special way. Pastor Lompo shared about a tragedy in his nation and why these refugees had to flee.

"Inter-community clashes led to a massacre of more than a hundred people and caused more than 12,000 refugees to flee. The refugee camp of Barsalgho contains more than 4,000 people and this is where we chose to share the love of Christ and the shoes you sent to us. When we arrived, the political and administrative leaders of the region gave us permission to share freely with the huge group that they listened gathered, and every word. These people lost everything (even family) and they are looking for Hope. Jesus is the answer

Some of them informed us that their children did not go to school, because they did not have a single pair of shoes. Honestly, each person who received a pair of shoes was so thankful to God. They confessed that they are not be able to get such a nice pair of shoes and this is a blessing they will never forget!"

Where In The World Is Nigeria?

Nigeria is located in western Africa and became independent from the British in 1960. It has a population of almost two million people. Known as the "giant of Africa," Nigeria is the most populous country in Africa. It is inhabited by 250 ethnic groups, who speak over 250 languages. About half of the population is Christian and the other half is Muslim. The name Nigeria came from the Niger River that runs through it. Nigeria's largest source of income comes from oil exports, though due to former government corruption, the wealth was not used to better the economy. Because of this, many lack basic necessities.

SFJ just sent shoes to Nigeria for the first time. Please join us in prayer that the Lord will move on many hearts as their feet are washed and as they hear about God's love. Most of the shoes will be shared in prison ministry, and we are believing for a mighty move of God in these hearts and lives. We are grateful for this opportunity to partner with a new country and can't wait to see what the Lord will do!
