Our partner, Jonel sent the following report of a recent shoe distribution.

"The village just outside the city Buchanan has no church. It is easy to see the level of poverty in this village. Many children and adults walk barefoot every day and live in dirt houses. When we announced that we had come to distribute shoes free of charge, they burst into song, praising the Lord for remembering them. At the end of the distribution, mothers were seen dancing as they headed home with their children. Everyone was carrying a pair of shoes. A woman named Mamie Bah could not hold back her emotions, as she came dancing and rejoicing that she and her three children each received a pair of shoes. She exclaimed, 'The Lord has answered my

Burkina Faso - Shoe Distribution Update

Brother Lompo, our partner in Burkina Faso emailed this report to us recently.

"Our evangelization team chose the village of Dialgaye as a focus of our ongoing efforts. The goal is to plant a church there and we used the shoe distribution as a means of preparing the ground for this effort. Dialgaye is a predominantly Muslim village and it can be difficult to visit some neighborhoods with the Gospel. The distribution of the shoes took place in front of the village chief's home. More than 400 pairs of shoes were distributed that day. The people were amazed that Christians came this time with gifts to help people instead of only with the Bible in their hands. Some people exclaimed: 'Today is different from other times. We have so many needs and today one of the great needs of this area was met. Thank God!' As a result of this distribution, there is now a place to worship the one true God in this village."

Malawi. The country is nicknamed "*The Warm Heart of Africa*," because of the friendliness of the people. English is the official language, though many different native languages are spoken. Malawi became independent from the United Kingdom in 1964, and is among the world's least-developed countries. The economy is heavily based in agriculture, with a largely rural population, and the government relies heavily on outside aid. Malawi has a low life expectancy, high infant mortality and a high prevalence of HIV/AIDS. Life expectancy is only 50 years. In January 2015, southern Malawi was devastated by the worst floods in living memory. These floods affected more than a million people across the country, including 336,000 who were displaced, according to UNICEF. Over 100 people were killed and an estimated 158,000 acres of cropland were washed away.

SFJ sent our first shipment of shoes to Malawi in 2017. Please join us in prayer for the lives that have been touched by these shoes and for those that still will be as distributions continue.
