We are thrilled to introduce Pastor Lompo Kangabaliba as the Every Home for Christ National Director in Burkina Faso. Pastor

Kangabaliba is known by many as Robert (for short). He is married to Naomi and they have five children: Georgette, Debora, Michée, Abdiel and Schipra. Robert believes that our partnership is used by God to help open people's hearts to hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ in his nation.

Robert has a goal to work with the EHC team in Burkina Faso to reach over 685,000 homes with the Gospel this year, so he is very busy working to coordinate that effort. In addition to this, he wants to see 2,000 people join the Discipleship Training Program and he also wants to help establish at least 60 new churches.

He shared with us that during a recent

Where In The World Is Sao Tome and Principe?

Sao Tome and Principe, (English translation Saint Thomas and Prince), is an island country in the Gulf of Guinea and consists of two small islands about 87 miles apart. The country gained its independence from Portugal in 1975. The population is about 200,000, and their main export is cocoa. This small country is often overlooked, so we are very excited that God opened the door for us to send our very first shipment here last month! Please pray for our partner, Jose Carlos, and all of the people who will be hearing the Good News for the first time!
