The work of evangelism and shoe distribution is going strong in the Republic of Benin! We received the following report from our partner, "Last week we went to the village of Akogoe near the border of Benin and Togo. Most of the people in this village are farmers, and they are also fetish worshipers. This means they believe certain objects have supernatural powers, so they worship and venerate those objects. This and there is a very high rate of poverty and most of the children walking barefoot. We went there to share the Gospel and it was miraculous to see people turn their worship to the one true God, who alone is worthy of their joy to the village as many hearts received Jesus as Lord!
