The Republic of Ghana is located in West Africa, along the shores of the Atlantic Ocean. It is bordered by the countries of Togo, Ivory Coast, and Burkina Faso. Lying near the equator, Ghana has a warm climate with coastal, forest, and savanna landscapes. Ghana is home to nearly 31 million people, and more than half of the population is employed by the agriculture, forestry, and fishing High-guality industries. cacao is a major export for the growing economy, along with mining of minerals such gold, diamonds, as manganese, and bauxite (an aluminum ore). Ghana has developed a strong education system and about 75% of

the adult population is literate. Religions of the area include Christianity, Islam, and mixed traditional practices. Please join us in praying for this nation as God is moving in exciting ways!
