












Dear Friend,

Meet One of Our Ministry Directors

Meet our Every Home for Christ Ministry Director in Lesotho, Josias

Mohanoe. Since giving his life to Christ in 1987, Josias has dedicated himself to reaching the forgotten and remote communities of Lesotho with the Gospel. Under Josias' leadership, the EHC Lesotho team reaches neglected people, herd boys, widows, disabled, and others in remote



mountainous areas— not just with the message of Jesus, but with tangible expressions of love.

One powerful story comes from Phamong in the Mohale's Hoek district, where the team met a man considered mentally ill and abandoned by his own family. After washing his feet and giving him shoes, he raised his hands and accepted Christ. Today, that man is healing, working, and living a transformed life—a testament to the power of the Gospel and the love behind it. Lesotho faces immense challenges. Child-headed families, a result of past pandemics, have forced children into adult responsibilities. Early child marriage and drug abuse are on the rise, especially among young girls and boys seeking protection or identity. Despite this, Josias sees hope. He shares, "The majority of people in my country are receptive to the Gospel—that alone gives hope." The promises of 2 Corinthians 5:17 (Josias's favorite Bible verse) echo this hope: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

Where in the World is Lesotho?



The country of Lesotho is a small landlocked nation, surrounded entirely by South Africa. Similar in size to the combined area of Rhode Island and Massachusetts, Lesotho is home to two million people, 99.7% of whom are part of the Sotho ethnic group. Lesotho translates to "land of the Sesotho speakers" (the native language) and was formed in 1822 and became a British royal colony in 1884 until its independence in 1966. Lesotho is generally reliant on imports of food to sustain its relatively dense population, as land suitable for growing crops is limited and droughts frequently affect harvests and livestock. Primary education is free and mandatory; thus, Lesotho has one of the highest literacy rates among African nations, nearly 80% of the population. Unfortunately, HIV/AIDS has a major impact in Lesotho, and the nation has one of the highest rates of infection in the world. Young women account for over half of reported cases, and thus the number of children living with HIV has also risen largely due to mother-to-child transmission. We pray that new doors will be opened for the Gospel across Lesotho and that people will be transformed by the saving love of Jesus!
