





Where in the World is Chad?



Chad, a landlocked nation in north-central Africa, lies across a diverse landscape of desert, savanna, and wetland regions from the arid Sahara in the north to fertile lowlands around Lake Chad in the southwest. With a population of roughly 18 million people, Chad is ethnically and linguistically diverse, comprising more than 200 groups and languages, though French and Arabic are official languages. The economy relies heavily on agriculture, livestock, and oil production, which has become a crucial export since the early 2000s. However, despite its resource potential, Chad remains one of the world's poorest countries, facing challenges such as political instability, limited infrastructure, widespread poverty, and vulnerability to climate changes. Periodic droughts, desertification, and regional conflicts—particularly the spillover of violence from nearby Sudan and Libya—continue to strain the nation's social and economic development. May the Lord's faithful provision for the people of Chad demonstrate His love and turn hearts to Him!
